Rev. Albert Wagner is a globally recognized artist and part of a movement called “visionary” or “outsider” art. Outsider art is art created by untrained artists who are driven to their work by obsession, or in his case, divine revelation. He moved to Cleveland, OH in 1941. Until his death on September 1, 2006, at age 83, he created over 3,000 paintings and sculptures.
