

- 1. Clinical trials are designed to answer specific medical research questions.
- 2. Participation is always voluntary—you can leave a study whenever you want.
- 3. Clinical trials often need healthy volunteers to help answer research questions.
- 4. Your safety is a priority. Researchers must follow detailed rules and the safety requirements to make each trial as safe as possible.
- 5. The study will be explained to you in an informed consent process before you agree to join. You must sign a consent before any study activities can begin.
