REGISTRATION DEADLINES

You must register or update your voter registration no later than 30 days prior to an election.

Upcoming voter registration deadlines:

- **July 7, 2025** – for the August 5, 2025 Special Election
- **October 6, 2025** – for the November 4, 2025 General Election

Bring one of the following forms of valid photo identification:

- Ohio driver's license
- State of Ohio ID card
- Interim ID form issued by the Ohio BMV
- U.S. passport
- U.S. passport card
- U.S. military ID card
- Ohio National Guard ID card
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs ID card

All photo IDs must include:

- An expiration date that has not passed
- A photograph of the voter
- The voter's name, which must substantially match the name in the Poll List or Poll Book
