### Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) replaces D-U-N-S Number

The federal government has replaced the D-U-N-S® Number with a new unique entity identifier known as the Unique Entity ID. It is **free of charge** to obtain a UEI from SAM.gov as well as for all organizations required to register with the federal government.

- If you want to do business with the federal government, you now need a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) instead of a D-U-N-S Number.
- UEIs are issued through SAM.gov and are required for federal grants, contracts, and financial assistance not for tax filing.
- You'll need to verify your business identity and physical address as part of the registration process.
- Staying registered with SAM and managing your UEI helps you remain eligible for government funding opportunities.
