Coronavirus Information

COVID-19 symptoms can be mild or severe. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure—Fever, Cough, Shortness of breath, fatigue.

Transmission—thought to be spread mainly from person-to-person from respiratory droplets (coughing, sneezing, ect.) transferred from infected individuals to those who are within 6 feet of them

Protect Yourself and Family members

- Avoid gatherings of more than 10 people
- Visit loved ones electronically
- Practice social distancing—allow six feet between you and others, avoid touching
- COMMIT TO GOOD HAND HYGIENE—use alcohol based hand sanitizer, wash hands often for 20 seconds or more. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces
- Cough and sneeze in your elbow
- STAY HOME
- Reconsider non-essential social visits, errands and travel.
- When on essential trips with high traffic such as grocery stores, **wear a mask** and if possible, gloves

- **A census “email”**—contact is usually made by mail
- **Asking for money or financial data**—census never asks for this
- **Threats of arrest**—you can get fined for not participating, but not arrested

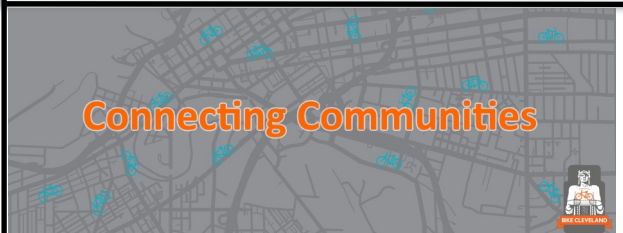
